### **Beneath the floor:**

there will be underfloor heating

### **Above the floor:**

there will be 250 new chairs

We plan to buy the Howe 40/4 chair, which is widely used in other churches and cathedrals. It is elegant, strong but lightweight, and ergonomically designed to fit the human body. 40 chairs can be stacked to a height of only 4 feet, and may be linked into rows of up to 4 chairs. This allows for quick and efficient setting up and clearing away. It will be ideal for the flexible usage we envisage for the nave on weekdays and on Sunday. The chair isn't cheap, but will endure for many, many years!

### **Tax claimed by the charity**

The Government will pay to the charity an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for the charity does not affect your personal tax position.

If you pay income tax at the higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax due to you.
